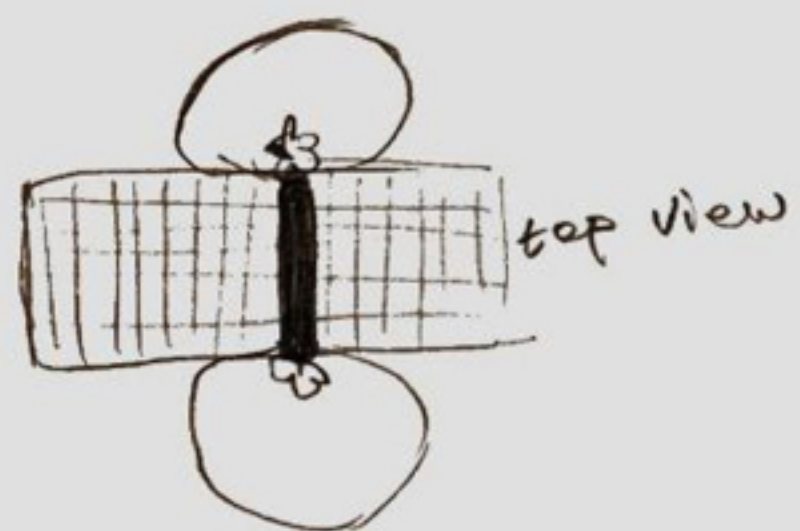
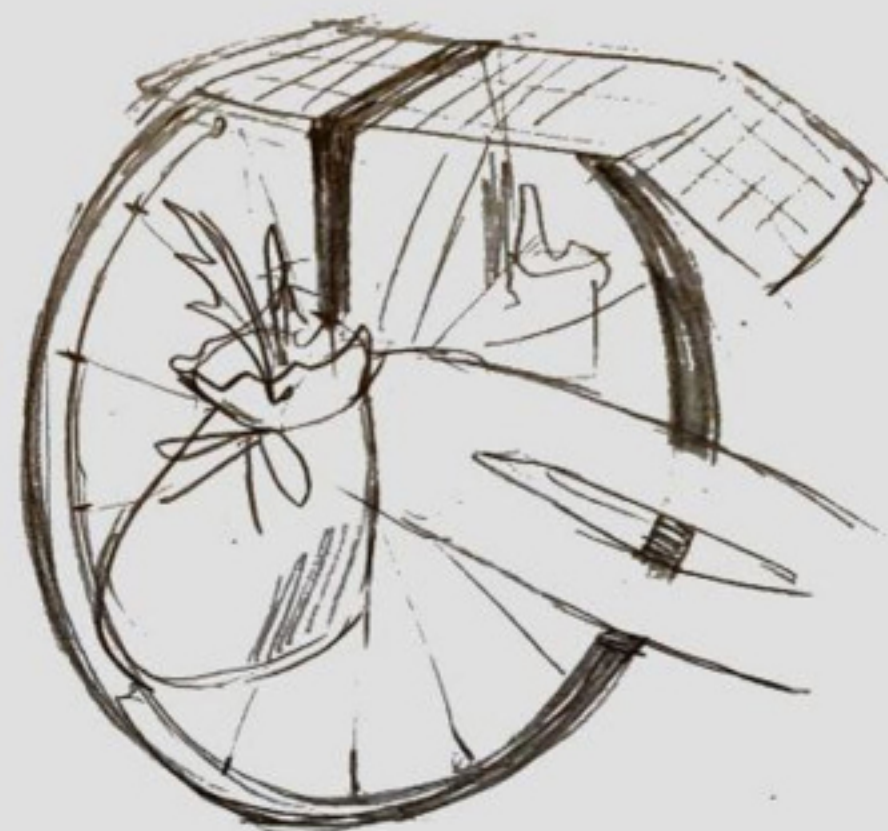
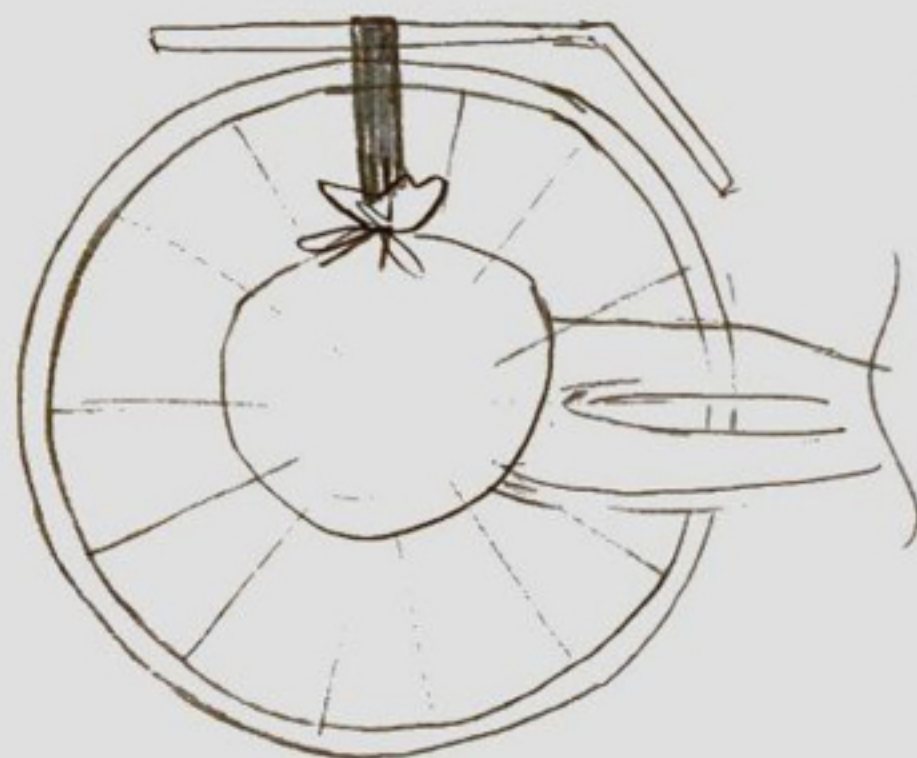


Questions

- Do you often come to climb the hill on a bicycle? Are there special devices in China to simplify lifting? (something like the image below)



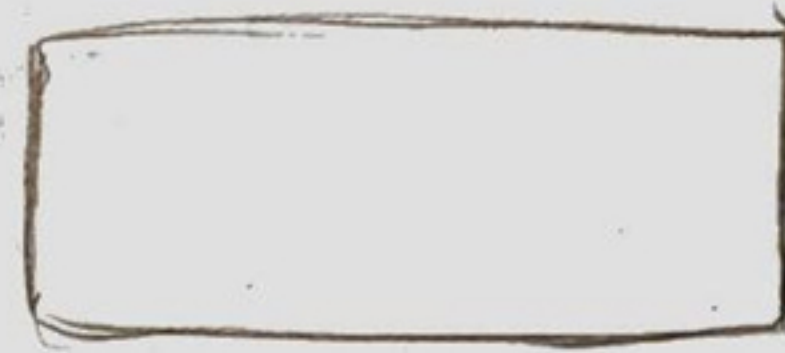
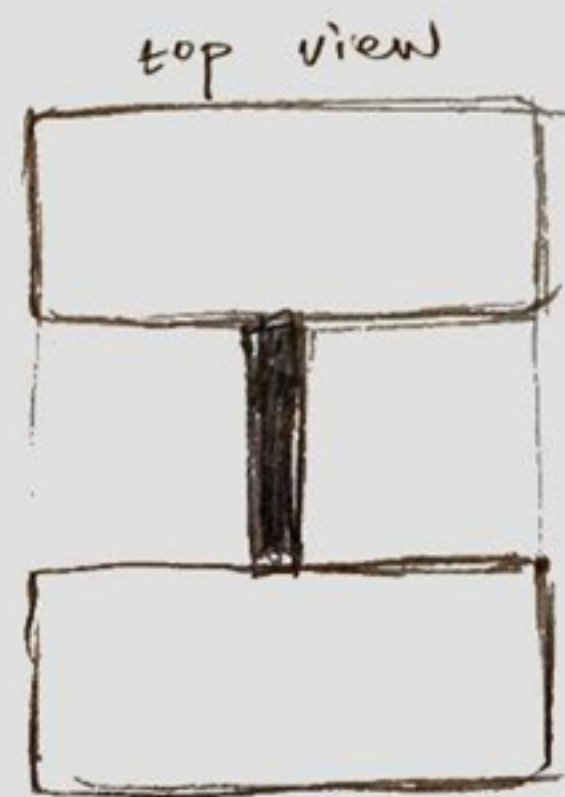
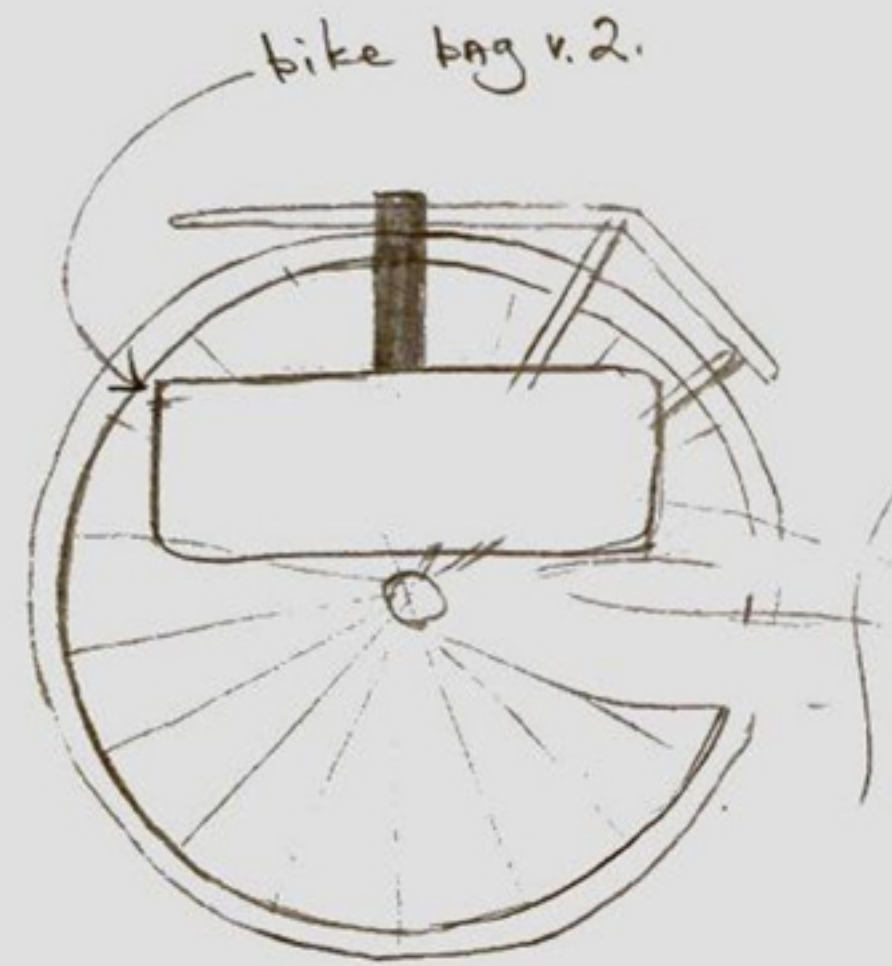

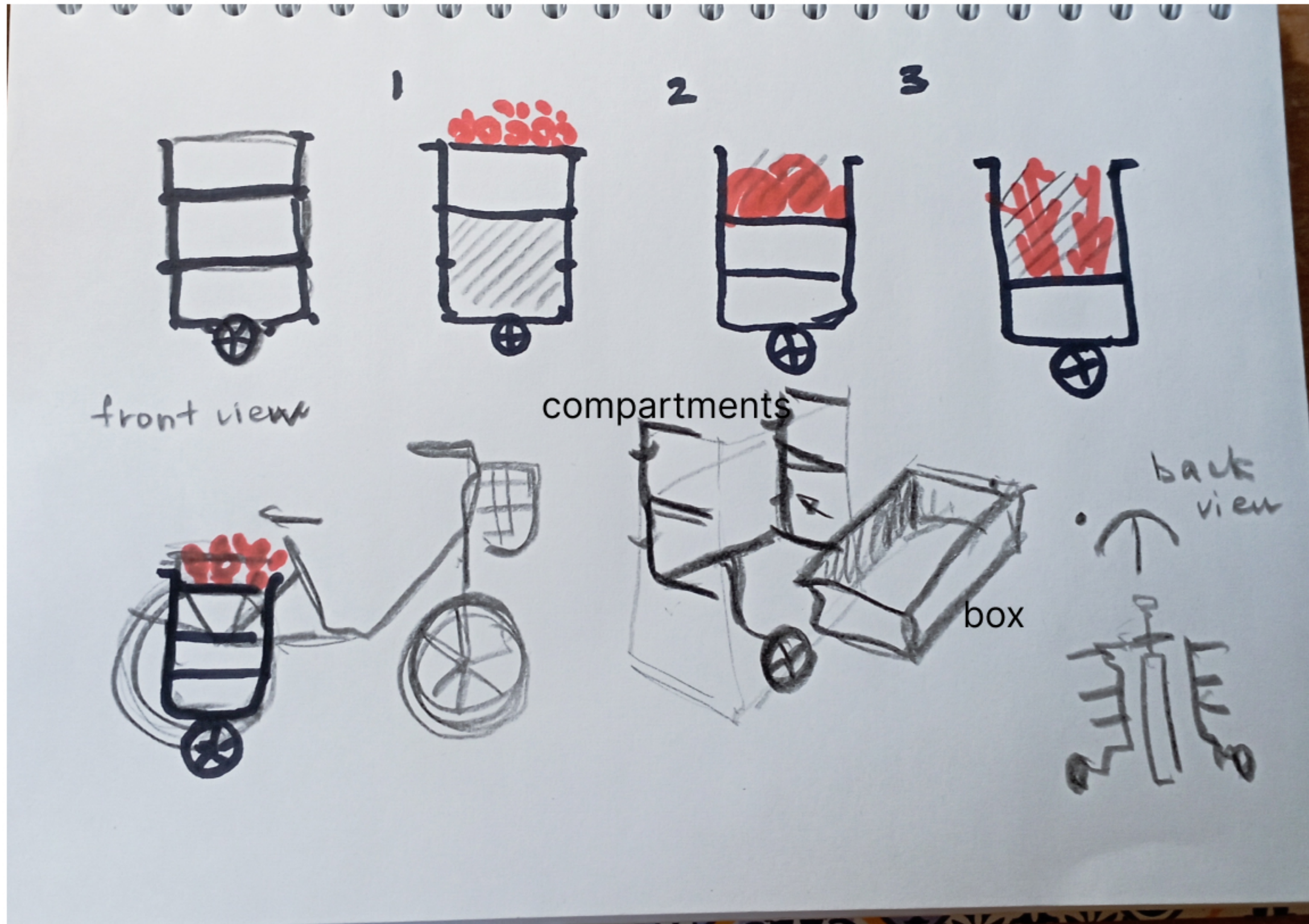


Idea 4

The device will have facial recognition of the owner and will use the camera to follow him. It can be turned on by remote control or by a small button that will be attached to the keys.



Idea 5



This is a metal frame with a wheel at the bottom, where the food boxes are inserted. The structure is attached on both sides and creates a four-wheeled bicycle from a two-wheeled bicycle. This will make the bike more stable. It doesn't matter what the load will be.

There will be 6 compartments and 4 boxes so that unused boxes can be moved to free compartments. As in option 3 or 1. Or just don't take some of the boxes with you.
