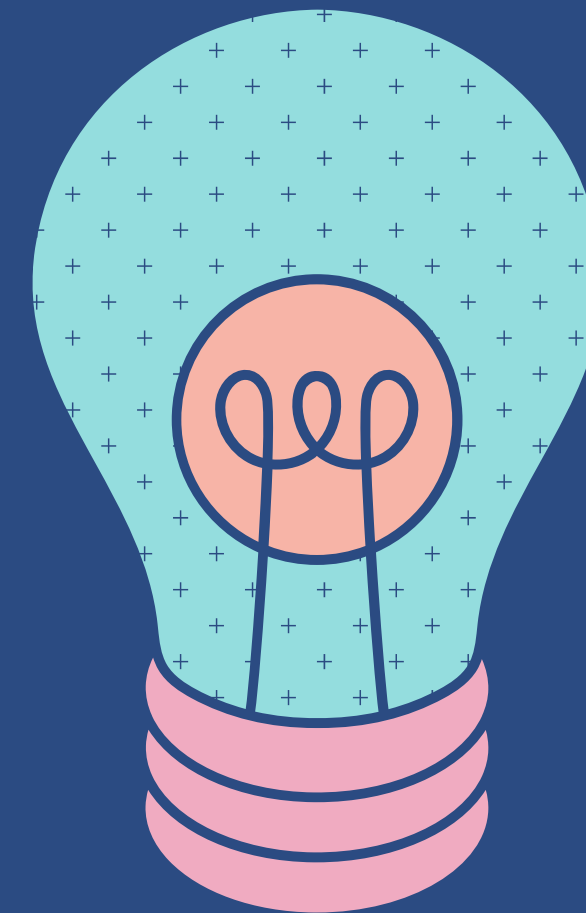


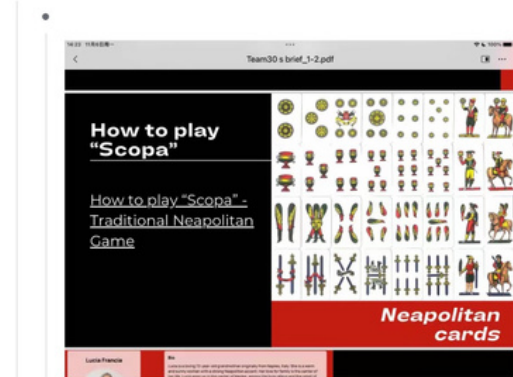
## THE MEETING MINUTES



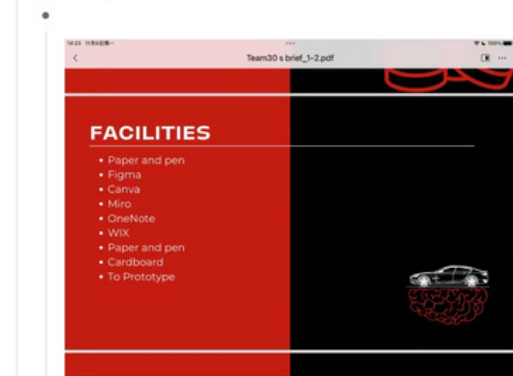
We had a group meeting and discussed and summarized the questions with the Team-30 brief.

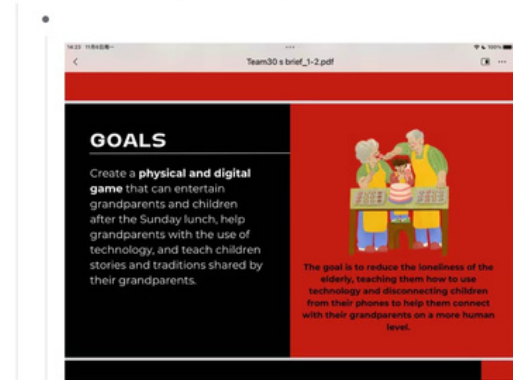
- What is your main purpose in introducing scopa play to us ?

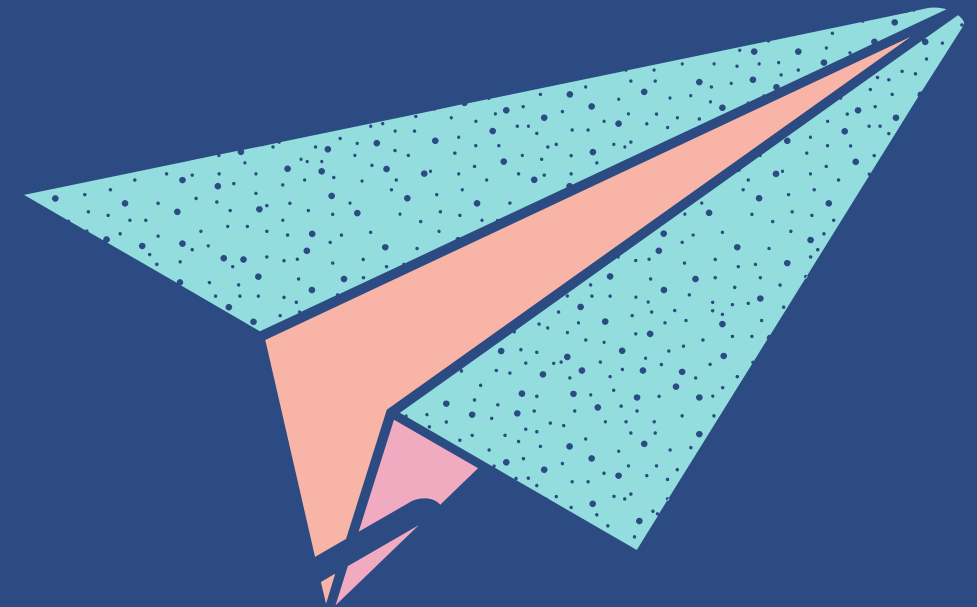

I've seen your brief, i wanted to ask if your request is, for example, related to a diary that the elderly want to preserve. In this case, an application could be designed to allow them to type or photograph the diary's pages and save them in a digital format. The app could also offer features to search for keywords within the diary and organize the recorded events or thoughts in a more accessible way. This way, diaries can be preserved digitally, freeing up physical space and making it easier to access memories

These audio recordings could be organized into a digital archive and played back when the elderly wish to relive those sensory experiences in a more engaging and personal way

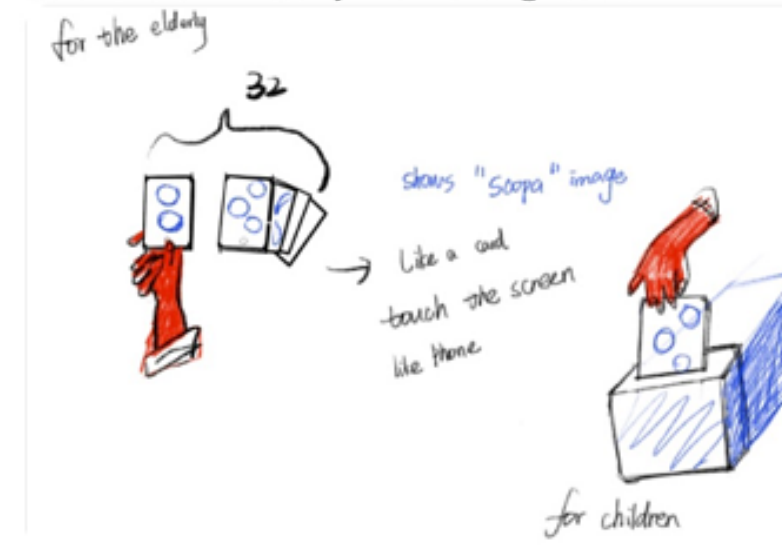
To make sure we've understood the theme
